



Dear Culinary Arts Students and Parents,

Welcome to the NOCCA Culinary Arts program!

The department fees required for each student will cover all the supplies, equipment, and field trip fees for the entire school year. All students, regardless of level, are required to pay the basic student fee. All students are required to have a NOCCA issued or approved knife kit, thermometer, NOCCA uniforms, and approved kitchen shoes. Please complete the enclosed form so that the Culinary Arts department may order some of your essentials. Uniforms must be maintained in good condition and be free of major stains. Individual pieces may also be purchased for an additional cost. To determine the total fee to be paid, add together the required fees for your student with any optional additional fees and remit that amount. Please return the form by mail to NOCCA, Attn: Culinary Arts, 2800 Chartres St., New Orleans, LA 70117 on or before **Friday, July 1, 2016**. Uniforms will be ordered using these forms so please be prompt in returning them. **Department fees must be paid in full by Friday, August 1, 2016. If you are applying for financial aid, please remit the form by July 1 and indicate that you will be applying for aid.**

**Shoes:** Shoes are to be purchased by the student prior to the first day of classes. Shoes must be all black, oil and slip resistant. Most of our students wear styles from Shoes for Crews purchased through the website [www.shoesforcrews.com](http://www.shoesforcrews.com). Acceptable styles in Men's shoes include Falcon (#6007), Frogg's Pro (#5008), Evolution (#8028) or Force (#8044). Acceptable styles in Women's shoes include Falcon (#7007), Frogg's Pro (#5008), Vitality (#9045) or Piper (#4306). Other acceptable styles of both men's and women's shoes are Professional clogs by Sanita or Dansko; again, plain black only.
