Here are some important dates for you to remember:

- July 27 Registration Process Complete (All Forms Turned in and All Department Fees Paid or Financial Aid Submitted)
- August 15 MANDATORY Student Prelude Session-This is a briefing for ALL NOCCA Students (new and returning). All Students must attend Prelude at the time of their art (for example, 1:15 students come at 1:15). Students will report to their art class for attendance.
- August 16 First Full Day of NOCCA Instruction (Academic Studio and Arts Conservatory)
 All families/students must complete the registration process and pay all fees or submit the financial aid form (enclosed) in order to take class on Aug 16. (As a reminder, all fees are non-refundable.)
- We are also offering a Parent Orientation Session hosted by your Arts Disciplines. (details to follow)

Step 1: Online

LOSFA Form (Academic Studio only)
The NOCCA Institute Financial Aid (If you choose to apply for financial aid)
Physical (All Academic Studio Students, Dance, Drama, Musical Theatre, and Theatre Design)

Step 3: Payment of Fees or Financial Aid Form

Families must *either* pay the Student Fee or submit a Financial Aid Form by the deadline. Please see the student fee letter in this packet for details.

Due: Friday, July 27, 2018

Please remember, students will only be allowed to start school when all three steps are complete!
