



Dear Culinary Arts Students and Parents,

Welcome to the NOCCA Culinary Arts program!

There are some important dates to note. Student Prelude will take place on **Wednesday, August 15, 2018**. Students should report directly to his/her scheduled art class (i.e. if the student's class is from 1:15-3:45, the student should come to Prelude at 1:15). **This Prelude is a mandatory event.**

Thursday, August 16, 2018 is the first full day of Academic Studio and Arts instruction. If the student is in Academic Studio, he/she should report to school for 8:00 am. If the student is coming to NOCCA for their arts instruction only, he/she should arrive at the time their art class starts (i.e., 1:15pm or 4:00pm).

The department fees required for each student will cover all the supplies, equipment, and field trip fees for the entire school year. All students, regardless of level, are required to pay the basic student fee. All students are required to have a NOCCA issued or approved knife kit, thermometer, NOCCA uniforms, and approved kitchen shoes. Please complete the enclosed form so that the Culinary Arts department may order some of your essentials. Uniforms must be maintained in good condition and be free of major stains. Individual pieces may also be purchased for an additional cost. To determine the total fee to be paid, add together the required fees for your student with any optional additional fees and remit that amount. Please return the form with your payment or by mail to NOCCA, Attn: Culinary Arts, 2800 Chartres St., New Orleans, LA 70117 on or before Friday, July 13, 2018. Uniforms will be ordered using these forms so please be prompt in returning them so they are available at the start of the school year. Department fees must be paid in full by Friday, July 27, 2018. If you are applying for financial aid, please remit the form by July 27 and indicate that you will be applying for aid.

Shoes: Shoes are to be purchased by the student prior to the first day of classes. Shoes must be **all black**, oil and slip resistant and have a closed back. Most of our students wear styles from Shoes for Crews purchased through the website www.shoesforcrews.com. Other acceptable styles of both men's and women's shoes are Professional clogs by Sanita or Dansko or Emeril Lagasse styles; again, **plain black only**. These can be purchased online as well at www.clogoutlet.com or www.zappos.com or www.shoecarnival.com. **Crocs and regular street shoes are not acceptable for the NOCCA Culinary program.**
