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Theatre Design Expectations of Students/Families

Since ours is a comprehensive, demanding program intended for students who wish to seriously explore the art of Theatre Design, we want you to be prepared for the start of school by reading and understanding the following important items.

DAILY DRESS: Theatre Design students are expected to wear work clothes daily regardless of where they are working. Work clothes should comply with the departments regulations. Appropriate footwear must also be worn at all times. Appropriate footwear consists of lace up athletic shoes, canvas shoes with toe protection, or work boots only.

PERFORMANCE DRESS: Theatre Design students must have one set of PRODUCTION STAGE BLACKS.

Students failing to dress appropriately for class will be sent to the office and will not be allowed to participate in class. Students not dressed appropriately for a rehearsal or production will be required to contact a parent or guardian to bring them clothing prior to the performance. If a student violates the Theatre Design dress code policy (3) times in a semester, then the students grade will be dropped a full letter grade.

NOCCA PRODUCTIONS: Students are required to attend all NOCCA Theatre, Dance, and Vocal Music productions throughout the coming year. Non-attendance at these performances will result in a loss of credit (in accordance with the Enrollment Contract and the Student | Parent Handbook).

EXTRACURRICLAR WORK: No student may consider or accept any outside theatre work **before contacting and gaining permission in writing from the NOCCA Theatre Faculty**.

REQURIED SHOWS: Students will be required to see three professional outside theatre, music, or dance productions per semester that are not part of the NOCCA student season. **Failure to turn in all three papers will result in a zero and drop the students overall score for the semester a letter grade.**

REQUIRED TIME OUTSIDE OF NORMAL CLASS: Students will be required several times throughout the year to participate in the running of shows. This will entail having to remain at school after normal class dismissal for rehearsal and performances. If there is a student conflict with a mandatory attendance date, then that student needs to bring a written note from their parent explaining the situation as soon as the student finds out about the conflict. Unexcused absences on these dates will result in a loss of grades and repeated absences may result in dismissal from NOCCA.

GRADING AND HOMEWORK: Homework projects will be assigned throughout the year with expected guidelines and completion dates.
