

NOCCA COVID Guidance | Reminders & Updated CDC Guidance

NOCCA Campus Community:

NOCCA supports safe, in-person learning while managing the spread of COVID. Recently, the [CDC has updated its guidance](#).

For Review:

- Vaccination against COVID is strongly recommended.
- If your student has an illness and/or shows symptoms of COVID-19, they should remain home and update frontdesk@nocca.com with their absence.
- Anyone with COVID-19 symptoms, regardless of vaccination status, should be tested for COVID-19. Routine weekly testing for COVID is offered to the campus community at NOCCA each Tuesday, [registration is required](#).
- Members of the campus community should alert frontdesk@nocca.com when they test positive for COVID.
- If confirmatory testing is positive, the symptomatic person has COVID-19 and should complete at-home 5 day isolation wearing a mask through day 10.

Updated Quarantine Process

Where possible, classroom settings are structured to keep students at least 3 feet apart from one another. Students who are less than 3 feet from an infected person will be treated as having close contact.

- Members of the campus community who are in close contact to a person who tests positive for COVID-19 will be notified.
- Close contact is determined by NOCCA.
- People who are exposed (in close contact) to the virus no longer need to quarantine at home, regardless of their vaccination status. However, they should mask for 10 days and get tested on day 5. NOCCA is able to coordinate this testing on-site with parent permission.
- Students should watch for symptoms for 10 days wearing a mask following close contact with a person who tested positive.
