

Department of Public Safety Campus Traffic guidelines

DPS Police Officers ask that you adhere to the following campus traffic guidelines:

When dropping off students at the G Building,

- 1) Drive in the correct lane on Homer Plessy Way. If you are dropping off a student, you should be driving towards the river. If necessary, drive around the block so that you are driving in the correct direction. Do not turn left, directly onto Homer Plessy Way from Chartres St. This will cause a traffic jam and create an unsafe environment for you as well as your child.
- 2) Do not linger in the drop-off area. Have your student leave the car shortly after you pull in so that other cars may pull forward to drop off students.

When picking up students from NOCCA's Main campus:

- 1) Traffic entering NOCCA's Main Campus should enter via Homer Plessy Way. There will be no left or right turns from Chartres Street.
- 2) The speed limit on NOCCA's campus is 5 miles per hour (mph), this includes in front of the buildings and in the parking lot.
- 3) **Do not use cell phones in our school zone.** It's the law! (Louisiana revised statute title 32:300.8)
- 4) The flow of traffic into the driveway is one way toward the river.
- 5) Remember to stop for pedestrians and do not block the crosswalk.
- 6) Keep the center lane clear for moving traffic.
- 7) When arriving early (20 minutes or more before dismissal), form a single line along the right curb (fire lane) or to the left side and pull your vehicle all the way up to the light poles (on the left) and the end of the fence (on the right).
- 8) Once students are released, pay attention and move up as cars in front of you move.
- 9) Do not park in visitor parking spaces during dismissal. You will be blocked in and will have to wait to back out. All visitors in visitors parking must exit the driveway to the right.
- 10) Remain in your vehicle at all times. Have your child wait for you at the steps or in the breezeway where they can see you. If you need to leave your vehicle, you must park in the large lot.
- 11) When the driveway is full, park your vehicle in large lot (across the train tracks) and walk over to pick up your child.
- 12) When the driveway and parking lots are full, which occurs each day due to the high volume of traffic, cars will not be allowed to line up on Chartres St. DPS police officers will direct vehicles past the campus. You will go to the corner of Montegut St., take a left onto Royal St., and another left onto Homer Plessy Way to line-up at the corner of Homer Plessy Way and Chartres. Vehicles will remain in this area until a DPS police officer directs them into the NOCCA driveway.

The above pick-up procedure guidelines are subject to change.

Our primary concern is the safety of all students, parents, faculty, and staff. Secondly, we want a smooth and timely dismissal.
